"By better accommodating a larger hose, we improved the flow rate and pressure, which enhanced our overall performance by 20–30%," said Gerbasi. "Our sales grew the first year we launched it. When you're supplying equipment for the pros, quality matters. And clearly the quality of Hannay reels is much better."
